SUNO administrator serves second term on national organization's leadership team



NEW ORLEANS, LA. – Dr. Brenda Wesley Jackson, Director of Title III Programs for Southern University at New Orleans, was re-elected for a second term as Vice President of the National Association of HBCU Title III Administrators, Inc. at its annual meeting on June 25, 2009 in Memphis, TN.

The membership of the organization includes Title III administrators and Title III-related activity directors of all Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs). The purpose of the National Association of HBCU Title III Administrators is to provide information, technical assistance and serve as an advocate to help advance and strengthen

HBCU programs in order to provide a quality education to all its students.
