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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The number of enrolled 2004-2005 ACT-tested freshmen (317) represents (17%) of the students who elected to send ACT score reports to your campus. Enrolled counts shown in this report are limited to those students your institution identified as enrolled full-time and degree seeking. It is assumed that enrolled students for whom a full-time/degree seeking status was not provided are full-time/degree seeking.

The average ACT composite score for your ACT-tested enrolled freshmen was 14.9 (men = 14.7, women = 15.1). The national ACT composite for 2003-2004 high school graduates was 20.9.
