Signs of progress at Small Business Incubator

Construction workers drive pilings for the **Small Business Incubator** next to the College of Business & Public Administration on the Lake Campus. Window frames installed at Bashful Building



Workers are installing window frames on the back of the **Emmett Bashful Administration Building**, while the front of the building looks neater now that dirt has been filled in around portions of the completed floodwall.

Brickwork near completion



At the **Library**, the bricklaying is about 99 percent complete. The next big part of the renovation project is the installation of the terrazzo flooring, which is scheduled to begin by the end of the month.
