



## Campus Announcement

### **The National Historically Black College and University Research Network for Health Services and Health Disparities Award Announcement of 2008 Grant Competition**

**Purpose** The National HBCU Research Award Grant is designed to provide a funding opportunity for faculty who are pursuing research on health services and health disparities among African-Americans. The research can focus on experiences of these populations explored from the social, economic, political, or medical impact on the health conditions of this culturally diverse population.

**Eligibility** All faculty who hold an academic appointment at the rank of associate professor, assistant professor, research associate, or instructor at any of the Historically Black Colleges or Universities. Only one proposal per investigator will be considered.

**Funding** Two Grants of \$1,200 each will be awarded within three months of the announcement of the recipients.

**Review Process** Applications will be reviewed by the National HBCU Research Network Award Selection Committee.

**Criteria** Proposals will be reviewed for quality of proposed project; significance in advancing the understanding of health disparities of African American's; and qualifications of the principal investigator to carry out and complete scope of work defined within the one year of the award. Proposal must include the method, purpose, significance of the project, goals, objectives, expected outcomes, and policy implications.
