EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The number of enrolled 1998-99 ACT-tested freshmen (297) represents (17%) of the students who elected to send ACT score reports to your campus. The average ACT composite score for your ACT-tested enrolled freshmen was 14.7 (men = 14.7, women = 14.7). The national ACT composite for 1997-98 high school graduates was 21.0.
