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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The number of enrolled 1999-2000 ACT-tested freshmen ( 292) represents ( 17%) of the students who elected to send ACT score reports to your campus. The average ACT composite score for your ACT-tested enrolled freshmen was 14.6 (men = 14.7, women = 14.5). The national ACT composite for 1998-99 high school graduates was 21.0.
