EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The number of enrolled 2000-2001 ACT-tested freshmen (254) represents (15%) of the students who elected to send ACT score reports to your campus. The average ACT composite score for your ACT-tested enrolled freshmen was 14.7 (men = 14.7, women = 14.8). The national ACT composite for 1999-2000 high school graduates was 21.0.
