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## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The number of enrolled 2002-2003 ACT-tested freshmen ( 182) represents ( 10%) of the students who elected to send ACT score reports to your campus. Enrolled counts shown in this report are limited to those students your institution identified as enrolled full-time and degree seeking. It is assumed that enrolled students for whom a full-time/degree seeking status was not provided are full-time/degree seeking.

The average ACT composite score for your ACT-tested enrolled freshmen was 14.2 (men = 14.5, women = 14.0). The national ACT composite for 2001-2002 high school graduates was 20.8.
