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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The number of enrolled 2006-2007 ACT-tested freshmen (81) represents (7%) of student score reports received by your campus. Enrolled counts shown in this report are limited to those students your institution identified as enrolled full-time and degree seeking. It is assumed that enrolled students for whom a full-time/degree seeking status was not provided are full-time/degree seeking.

The average ACT composite score for your ACT-tested enrolled freshmen was 14.6 (men = 14.3, women = 14.8). The national ACT composite for 2005-2006 high school graduates was 21.1.
