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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The number of enrolled 2016-2017 ACT-tested freshmen (119) represents (5%) of student score reports received by your campus. The average ACT composite score for your ACT-tested enrolled freshmen was 17.6 (men = 17.6, women = 17.6). The national ACT composite for 2015-2016 high school graduates was 20.8.
