APPLICATION FOR UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION

#### INSTRUCTIONS:

A \$20 non-refundable fee is required of all applicants—a \$30 fee for international applicants. An application will not be processed without the required fee. Money orders should be made payable to Southern University at New Orleans and submitted with a completed application. All supporting documents for admission must be received by the SUÑO Office of Admissions before acceptance can be granted. All records submitted become the property of the University and cannot be returned. **DO NOT SEND CASH.** 

#### <u>FRESHMAN ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:</u>

Louisiana graduates must meet the following.

- Board of Regents Core Requirement: 19 units from Core 4 Curriculum AND
- High school overall GPA of 2.0 or greater AND
- No more than one Developmental Course Needed (Required Scores: ACT English  $\geq$  18 and ACT Math  $\geq$  19 or SAT English  $\geq$  500 and SAT Math  $\geq$ 510)

#### AND ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- ACT composite score of 20 or greater OR
- Minimum Core GPA of 2.0 or greater.

\*Special consideration will be made for students who do not meet ACT subscores within a 3 point range. (BoR Policy 2.18)

Applicants who have never attended a post-secondary education institution must provide:

- An official high school transcript (including date of graduation) or the General Education Diploma (GED) scores. Students currently attending high school may be admitted Provisionally with a seven semester transcript pending graduation. Final transcripts with date of graduation indicated must be received within 30 days of the close of school
- ACT/SAT scores, and
- 3. A copy of immunization record or request for exemption (required of all admitted students prior to Registration).

#### TRANSFER STUDENT REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants who have attended regionally accredited post-secondary education institutions prior to applying to Southern University at New Orleans must:

- Submit final official college transcripts from each college/ university attended. Faxed transcripts are not official and will not be accepted. Failure to acknowledge attendance at a college or university may result in dismissal from SUNO.
- Have earned a Transferable Associate Degree; OR
- 3. Have earned a minimum of 18 hours with a minimum GPA of 2.3 on all college-level course work. Must have taken and passed college-level English and Math. Must have taken and passed college-level English and Math.
- Have a transfer reference sheet sent directly from each college/ 5. university attended.
- 6. Provide a copy of immunization record or request for exemption (required for all admitted students prior to registration).

#### PPLICATION DEADLINES:

Fall Semester ...... July 1 Spring Semester ...... December 1 Summer Semester ...... May 1

#### TRANSIENT/SPECIAL/SUMMER ONLY STUDENTS:

Applicants enrolled in another institution and desire admission for a limited period must submit a Letter of Good Standing or Official Transcript from the institution where they are currently enrolled. New Freshmen are never considered Transient, Special Students or Summer Only Students.

Applicants currently in good standing at an accredited college who wish to enroll one semester at SUNO, and who plan to return to their institution, may be admitted as TRANSIENT/SPECIAL/SUMMER ONLY STUDENTS. Such admission status will terminate at the end of the term and does not represent admission to SUNO.

#### INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS:

Criteria for applicants from outside of the United States:

- An official or original high school or college transcript. If transferring credit from a non-U.S. college, transcripts must be translated and evaluated by an approved U.S. agency. Contact the Office of Recruitment, Admissions and Retention at (504) 286-5314 or toll-free at (866) 641-0295 for further information.
- TOEFL examination scores of 500, or 173 computer-based required for all, except for citizens of Africa who may submit West African Examinations or General Certificates of Education. Contact Educational Testing Service, Princeton, New Jersey 08540 for an application.
- Copy of VISA.
- Copy of immunization records or request for exemption (required for all admitted students prior to registration). Applicants must submit application and all records at least 90 days prior to registration to be considered for admission. An I-20 form will be issued only after all credentials have been submitted and the applicant has been officially admitted to the University.
- 5. A notarized Affidavit of Financial Support (NAOFS).
- 6. First-time freshmen applicants must meet out-of-state requirements.
- New Transfer Applicants must meet minimum transfer standards.

#### **POST-BACCALAUREATE:**

Applicants who wish to receive a post-baccalaureate degree must:

- Submit an official transcript from undergraduate degree-granting college/ university.
- Provide a copy of immunization records or request for exemption (required of all admitted students prior to registration).
- ALT-CERT students must submit three (3) officially sealed transcripts.

#### ACCREDITED HOME-SCHOOLED/OUT-OF-STATE/STUDENTS:

- Must meet minimum New Freshman Admission Standards; OR
- Students who have less than 19 but at least 17 units of the required Core 4 curriculum must have minimum 2.0 overall high school GPA; AND
  - No Developmental Courses Needed (Required Scores: ACT English  $\geq$  18 and ACT Math  $\geq$  19 or SAT English  $\geq$  450 and SAT Math  $\geq$  460) **AND**
  - Minimum 2.0 high school core GPA on those 17-18 units; OR
- Minimum ACT/SAT composite score of 20 AND
  - Minimum high school GPA of 2.0 AND
  - No Developmental Courses Needed (Required Scores: ACT English  $\geq 18$  and ACT Match  $\geq 19$  or SAT English  $\geq 450$  and SAT Math  $\geq$  460).
  - 2.18 Policy Required Scores: English 15, Math 16 and GPA 2.0
  - Conditional Admission: 15 Composite ACT, 15 in Math or English and 2.0 GPA
- Non-accredited Home Schools must present GED/HISET Scores for Admissions.

#### **GED/HISET STUDENTS**

- Students must submit an official copy of their scores from the state
- 2. ACT composite 3 points higher than the minimum (23), and meet the developmental course requirement (19 Math & 18 ENGL).

\*\*\*ACT Residual tests scores are allowed and testing is available on our campus for a non-refundable fee of \$25.00. In the event the student does not meet the required scores, testing results are nontransferable to other institutions. Students are not eligible to take the ACCUPLACER Exam under this rule.\*\*\*

#### ADULT STUDENTS AGES 25 AND OLDER

New freshmen ages 25 and older are required to meet the minimum admission criteria for first-time freshmen based upon the classification of their documents. For more information contact the Office of Admissions at 504-286-5314.
