

Federal Aid Limits:

Federal PELL Grant Lifetime Limit (PELL LEU)

A student may receive a total of 6 Pell Grant Scheduled Awards, measured by percentage of scheduled award(s) disbursed (Lifetime Eligibility Used, “LEU” up to 600 %). This limitation is not limited to students who received their first grant on or after July 1, 2008, as was the previous limit of 9 Scheduled awards. This includes all received Pell Grant awards.

Iraq & Afghanistan Service Grants LEU

A student may receive a total of 6 scheduled awards, measured by percentage of Scheduled award(s) disbursed (Lifetime Eligibility Used, “LEU” up to 400 %). This limitation is not limited to students who received their first grant on or after July 1, 2008, as was the previous limit of 9 Scheduled awards.

150% Limit on Subsidized Loans

Due to the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act, a new borrower on or after July 1, 2013 cannot receive subsidized loans for more than 150% of their published length of their educational program. The law states a borrower who becomes ineligible for subsidized loans because of the 150% limit is ineligible for interest subsidy benefits on all subsidized loans first disbursed to that borrower on or after July 1, 2013.
