### Fellows Scholarship

The Fellows Scholarship is the most comprehensive scholarship we offer here at SUNO. This scholarship awarded to students who have performed at a high level throughout their high school careers. This scholarship is for four years pending your academic performance. In order to maintain the scholarship you must have a minimum GPA of 3.25 each semester to maintain the scholarship. To qualify for this scholarship you must have the following:

1. High School Grade Point Average of 3.0
2. A minimum composite ACT score of 24 or the SAT equivalent which is 1160-1190.
3. Must be a first time student enrolled at full time status. 12hrs or greater

### Transfer Scholarship

The Transfer Scholarship is designed for incoming transfer student with strong credentials. Students transferring to SUNO are welcomed to extend their education with us and this scholarship rewards them for their academic progress thus far in their academic careers. The scholarship is good for 2 consecutive years (fall and spring) in the amount of \$1,000.00 total per the academic year. To qualify for this scholarship you must have the following:

1. Must be in good academic standing from previous school
2. 3.0 or above on all college-level coursework
3. Must have earned an Associate's Degree

### SUNO 1st

The SUNO 1st Scholarship is offered on a first come first serve basis. The awards are based on your incoming GPA and ACT or SAT test scores. You have possibility of being awarded up to \$2,500.00 pending your performance. This award is for your first year (fall and spring). To qualify for this scholarship you must have the following:

1. Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.3
2. Minimum ACT of 15 or SAT of 810-850
