The Instructional Designer will work with faculty teaching online to create expertly designed courses with engaging, accessible course content that is delivered via the LMS. The core responsibilities include designing online course templates, creating standardized course content, conducting regular course reviews for content quality and accessibility, ensuring that course content is compliant with ADA Standards for Accessible Design, helping faculty with course alignment, and improving teacher-student interaction, via electronic communication, discussions, and web-based interactive learning activities. The Online Instructional Designer will also make recommendations for online faculty professional development and training. This individual will report to the Director of E-Learning.
