*Post-Baccalaureate and SUSLA Students Cannot Apply and Cannot Be Appointed. *
Students with Holds on their accounts and those who have GPA's lower than a 2.5, or a 2.75 for special positions, i.e. (SGA President, Vice President or Miss SUNO, need not apply. Please carefully read each statement throughout this entire packet and sign it verifying that you understand the qualifications and penalties for the positions in which you are seeking.

Please keep the first three (3) pages for your records and return the application.

I am currently enrolled as a full-time student at Southern University at New Orleans. Furthermore, I certify that I am an undergraduate/graduate student. I anticipate completing the next full year at Southern University at New Orleans. The Student Government Association (SGA) of Southern University at New Orleans shall be an Undergraduate Organization with one (1) Graduate President and one (1) Graduate Senator to represent the Graduate Colleges. NOTE: All transfer students must have completed at least one (1) semester of coursework at Southern University at New Orleans.

If seeking to become the SGA President, SGA Vice-President, or Class President, you must adhere to the following qualifications:

SGA President

- 1. Must have an overall grade point average of at least 2.75 after repeats and deletes.
- 2. Must have at least a Sophomore or Junior classification or 30 or more semester hours completed at the time of election.
- 3. Must have at least one (1) year of prior service to the Student Government Association (SGA) to qualify for this position.
- 4. Must have completed at least two (2) semesters of coursework at Southern University at New Orleans.

SGA Vice-President

- 1. Must have an overall grade point average of at least 2.75 after repeats and deletes.
- 2. Must have at least a Sophomore or Junior classification or 30 or more semester hours completed at the time of election.
- 3. Must have at least one (1) year of prior service to the Student Government Association (SGA) to qualify for this position.
- 4. Must have completed at least two (2) semesters of coursework at Southern University at New Orleans.

Class President

- 1. Must have an overall grade point average of at least 2.5 after repeats and deletes.
- 2. Classification must be commensurate with Class position. Example: If a student wishes to run for Junior Class President, he/she may be a Sophomore at the time of this election but MUST be a Junior when his/her term begins.
- 3. Must have completed at least two (2) semesters of coursework at Southern University at New Orleans.

Chief Justices

- 1. Must have an overall grade point average of at least 2.75 after repeats and deletes.
- 2. Must have at least a Sophomore or Junior classification or 30 or more semester hours completed at the time of election.
- 3. Must have at least one (1) year of prior service to the Student Government Association (SGA) to qualify for this position.
- 4. Must have completed at least two (2) semesters of coursework at Southern University at New Orleans.

Miss Southern University at New Orleans (MISS SUNO)

- 1. Must have an overall grade point average of at least 2.75 after repeats and deletes.
- 2. Must be classified as Junior with 60 90 hours of completed coursework at the time of the election.
- 3. Must be Single (never married) female.
- 4. Miss SUNO and her Royal Court should Not be or become pregnant during her reign, nor should they have any children.
- 5. The runner-up to Miss SUNO shall fill any portion of an unexpired term.
- 6. Must have at least one (1) year of prior service to the University (i.e. SGA or any other recognized Student Organization on the campus of Southern University at New Orleans) to qualify for this position.
- 7. Must have successfully completed at least two (2) semesters of coursework at Southern University at New Orleans.

Other Royal Court Members, Miss Sophomore, Miss Junior and Miss Senior:

Must also be a single female never married, must Not be or become pregnant, nor should she have any children during her reign. Candidates:

- 1. Must have an overall grade point average of at least 2.5 after repeats and deletes.
- 2. Classification must be commensurate with Class position. *Example: If she wishes to run for Miss Senior, she may be a member of the Junior class at the time of this election but MUST be a member of the Senior class at the start of her reign.*
- 3. Shall represent Miss SUNO at events when Miss SUNO is unable to attend.

- 4. Must have at least one (1) year of prior service to the University (i.e. SGA or any other recognized Student Organization on the campus of Southern University at New Orleans) to qualify for this position.
- 5. Must have successfully completed at least two (2) semesters of coursework at Southern University at New Orleans.

Senior, Junior, and Sophomore Student Senators:

- 1. Must have an overall grade point average of at least 2.5 after repeats and deletes as defined by the Registrar's Office.
- 2. Classification must be commensurate with Class position. Example: If a student wishes to run for Junior Class Senator, he/she may be a Sophomore at the time of this election but MUST be a Junior when his/her term begins. If for some reason at the end of the term you have not earned the GPA required to remain in this position, you will forfeit your status.

MANDATORY Zoom Meeting for ALL QUALIFIED Candidates: Tuesday, April 13, 2021 at 2:00 p.m. Failure to attend this meeting will eliminate you from the campaigning process. If an emergency should arise, please contact Mrs. Mary Jackson prior to the meeting. Failure to attend this meeting will result in your inability to campaign.

Campaigning Begins: Wednesday, April 14, 2021 thru Sunday, April 18, 2021.

Again, as a reminder, if you do not attend the mandatory meeting, you will not be allowed to campaign. Therefore, you will be jeopardizing your eligibility for this Spring 2021 Election. CAMPAIGN MANAGERS MUST BE FULL-TIME STUDENTS!!!!!!

<u>Election Day</u>: Monday, April 19, 2021. Voters will vote electronically from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. There should be no campaigning from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

The original grade is disregarded for the purpose of determining the student's grade point average, hours passed, and hours earned; however, BOTH THE ORIGINAL AND REPEATED COURSE GRADES ARE COMPUTED IN DETERMINING A STUDENT'S ELIGIBILITY FOR HOLDING OFFICE AND GRADUATING WITH HONORS. In the case of repeating a course, the last grade and credits made shall be used in computing the grade point average ratio."

If you are running for an office or building an office, your grade point average from Banner will not be used. Your grade point average will be calculated using the formula above for repeat/delete. AGAIN, REPEATS AND DELETES WILL BE FACTORED INTO DETERMINING YOUR GPA AND ELGIBILITY.
