**NEW ORLEANS, LA** — Southern University at New Orleans (SUNO) is deeply saddened to announce the passing of Dr. Samuel Eweni, a respected Associate Professor in the College of Business and Public Administration, where he taught in the Computer Information Systems program.

Dr. Eweni tragically lost his life in a recent incident in the Little Woods community of New Orleans. A dedicated educator, scholar, and mentor, Dr. Eweni was a valued member of the SUNO family whose work touched the lives of countless students and colleagues. His commitment to academic excellence, innovation in technology education, and unwavering dedication to his students reflected the very best of Southern University at New Orleans.

Dr. Eweni was more than an educator—he was a mentor and a guiding light to so many of our students," said Dr. Joseph Bouie, Jr., Chancellor of Southern University at New Orleans. "His contributions to the College of Business and Public Administration and to the university's mission of transforming lives through education will be remembered and celebrated.
